CLASS DOJO

You may have heard your boy talk about Class Dojo at home. Class Dojo is an online behaviour management tool which is used by most teachers in our school. It is a fun, interactive and visual experience for the boys. At the beginning of the year each boy gets their own avatar to which points can be assigned for positive behaviour. Examples include being kind, great manners, good effort, healthy eating. Points can be removed for reasons including disruptive behaviour, incomplete homework or not being a good friend. Teachers reward boys in different ways e.g. Room 8 can cash in their points for homework passes and classroom rewards. Room 5 winners get a certificate and a prize on a Friday and Room 13 turn their points into raffle tickets. In most cases points get reset at the end of each week.
